### VINEYARDS & VITICULTURE

Nat Cool is about producing low-intervention, terroir driven wines from indigenous varieties. In 2020, the Nat Cool range grew, with its foray into Portugal's Dão region, on the slopes of the Serra da Estrela Mountain Range.

### HARVEST & VINIFICATION

The grapes are manually harvested and the wines undergo malolactic fermentation in stainless steel, and age for six months in stainless steel.
